Its full title was *On the Origin of Species by Means of Natural Selection, or the Preservation of Favoured Races in the Struggle for Life*. For the sixth edition of 1872, the short title was changed to *The Origin of Species*. Darwin's book introduced the scientific theory that populations evolve over the course of generations through a process of natural selection. It presented a body of evidence that the diversity of life arose by common descent through a branching pattern of evolution. Darwin included evidence that he had gathered on the Beagle expedition in the 1830s and his subsequent findings from research, correspondence, and experimentation. Various evolutionary ideas had already been proposed to explain new findings in biology. There was growing support for such ideas among dissident anatomists and the general public, but during the first half of the 19th century the English scientific establishment was closely tied to the Church of England, while science was part of natural theology. Ideas

about the transmutation of species were controversial as they conflicted with the beliefs that species were unchanging parts of a designed hierarchy and that humans were unique unrelated to other animals The political and theological implications were intensely debated but transmutation was not accepted by the scientific mainstream The book was written for non specialist readers and attracted widespread interest upon its publication As Darwin was an eminent scientist his findings were taken seriously and the evidence he presented generated scientific philosophical and religious discussion The debate over the book contributed to the campaign by T H Huxley and his fellow members of the X Club to secularise science by promoting scientific naturalism Within two decades there was widespread scientific agreement that evolution with a branching pattern of common descent had occurred but scientists were slow to give natural selection the significance that Darwin thought appropriate During the eclipse of Darwinism from the 1880s to the 1930s various other mechanisms of evolution were given more credit With the development of the modern evolutionary synthesis in the 1930s and 1940s Darwin s concept of evolutionary adaptation through natural selection became central to modern evolutionary theory and it has now become the unifying concept of the life sciences

Summary of Darwin s theory Darwin s theory of evolution is based on key facts and the inferences drawn from them which biologist Ernst Mayr summarised as follows Every species is fertile enough that if all offspring survived to reproduce the population would grow fact Despite periodic fluctuations populations remain roughly the same size fact Resources such as food are limited and are relatively stable over time fact A struggle for survival ensues inference Individuals in a population vary significantly from one another fact Much of this variation is inheritable fact Individuals less suited to the environment are less likely to survive and less likely to reproduce individuals more suited to the environment are more likely to survive and more likely to reproduce and leave their inheritable traits to future generations which produces the process of natural selection inference This slowly effected process results in populations changing to adapt to their environments and ultimately these variations accumulate over time to form new species inference

On the Origin of Species Charles Darwin, 2016-02-22 INTRODUCTION When on board H M S Beagle as naturalist I was much struck with certain facts in the distribution of the inhabitants of South America and in the geological relations of the present to the past inhabitants of that continent These facts seemed to me to throw some light on the origin of species that mystery of mysteries as it has been called by one of our greatest philosophers On my return home it occurred to me in 1837 that something might perhaps be made out on this question by patiently accumulating and reflecting on all sorts of facts which could possibly have any bearing on it After five years work I allowed myself to speculate on the subject and drew up some short notes these I enlarged in 1844 into a sketch of the conclusions which then seemed to me probable from that period to the present day I have steadily pursued the same object I hope that I may be excused for entering on these personal details as I give them to show that I have not been hasty in coming to a decision My work is now nearly finished but as it will take me two or three more years to complete it and as my health is far from strong I have been urged to publish this Abstract I

have more especially been induced to do this as Mr Wallace who is now studying the natural history of the Malay archipelago has arrived at almost exactly the same general conclusions that I have on the origin of species Last year he sent to me a memoir on this subject with a request that I would forward it to Sir Charles Lyell who sent it to the Linnean Society and it is published in the third volume of the Journal of that Society Sir C Lyell and Dr Hooker who both knew of my work the latter having read my sketch of 1844 honoured me by thinking it advisable to publish with Mr Wallace s excellent memoir some brief extracts from my manuscripts I much regret that want of space prevents my having the satisfaction of acknowledging the generous assistance which I have received from very many naturalists some of them personally unknown to me I cannot however let this opportunity pass without expressing my deep obligations to Dr Hooker who for the last fifteen years has aided me in every possible way by his large stores of knowledge and his excellent judgment In considering the Origin of Species it is quite conceivable that a naturalist reflecting on the mutual affinities of organic beings on their embryological relations their geographical distribution geological succession and other such facts might come to the conclusion that each species had not been independently created but had descended like varieties from other species Nevertheless such a conclusion even if well founded would be unsatisfactory until it could be shown how the innumerable species inhabiting this world have been modified so as to acquire that perfection of structure and coadaptation which most justly excites our admiration Naturalists continually refer to external conditions such as climate food etc as the only possible cause of variation In one very limited sense as we shall hereafter see this may be true but it is preposterous to attribute to mere external conditions the structure for instance of the woodpecker with its feet tail beak and tongue so admirably adapted to catch insects under the bark of trees In the case of the misseltoe which draws its nourishment from certain trees which has seeds that must be transported by certain birds and which has flowers with separate sexes absolutely requiring the agency of certain insects to bring pollen from one flower to the other it is equally preposterous to account for the structure of this parasite with its relations to several distinct organic beings by the effects of external conditions or of habit or of the volition of the plant itself The author of the Vestiges of Creation would I presume say that after a certain unknown number of generations some bird had given birth to a woodpecker and some plant to the misseltoe and that these had been produced perfect as we now see them but this assumption seems to me to be no explanation for it leaves the case of the coadaptations of organic beings to each other and to their physical conditions of life untouched and unexplained
